What will my flight be like?

Your Young Eagles flight will last approximately 20 minutes and you will see the earth and sky in a new and exciting way. This is your chance to experience the freedom of flight that many people only dream about. Many people remember this experience for the rest of their lives. **You will, too!**

- 1. On the ground: Your pilot explains what will happen during the flight. You may talk about the airplane, review an aeronautical chart (or map), and complete a careful "walkaround" preflight inspection of the airplane.
- Just before take off: Your pilot explains the interior of the airplane, including the operation of the aircraft door, safety belts, and instrument panel.

- 3. In the air: The flight lasts between 15 and 20 minutes. And, if you want, your pilot may let you take the controls!
- 4. Back on the ground: There's more time for you to ask questions about the flight. Your pilot is happy to tell you more about flying and their particular airplane.



EAA Young Eagles Flight Plan

Step 1: Young Eagles Flight

Start your aviation adventure with this actual flight experience. If you're between ages 8–17, you have the opportunity to go flying with an EAA member volunteer pilot. You'll experience what real pilots do on the ground and in the air.

Step 2: EAA Student Membership

Go to **YoungEagles.org/join** and enter the unique code that came with your logbook. Your free membership includes *EAA Sport Aviation* magazine online, e-newsletters, free admission to 300+ science and technology museums, and much more.

Step 3: Sporty's Learn to Fly Course

As an EAA Student Member, you'll receive free access to Sporty's Learn to Fly Course (\$199.99 value). This interactive online course uses realworld video and incredible 3D animations to help you learn the basics of flight. Plus, EAA will reimburse you when you pass your FAA written exam (\$150 value).

Step 4: First Flight Lesson

If you're at least 13 years of age and have completed the first three volumes of the Sporty's Learn to Fly Course, you'll qualify for a free first flight lesson at a flight school of your choice. This step is easy— EAA will contact you as soon as you qualify!
